Intercommunity Child Guidance Center Receives \$25,000 from the Albert & Bettie Sacchi Foundation

Whittier, CA - The Albert & Bettie Sacchi Foundation have granted \$25,000 in funding for 2000-07 that enables ICGC to continue to operate *Snug Harbor*, the agency's child care facility offering free child care services for families receiving treatment at the agency. ICGC recognizes the importance of providing parents with a safe and nurturing child care option to help diminish the obstacles many families encounter when seeking social services. *Snug Harbor* makes it possible for parents to take advantage of all the resources ICGC has to offer such as trainings and courses necessary to improve parenting skills and strengthen family life, which in turn create physically and emotionally safe environments for children.

The Sacchi Foundation is a private family foundation assisting non-profits engaged in child and protective services, and funds educational opportunities for financially or mentally disadvantaged youth/young adults.
